

In 2017, PolicyWise for Children and Families* was contracted by Alberta Health, a provincial government ministry, to support the development, implementation, and evaluation of community-based integrated service delivery hubs to address mental health needs of youth across Alberta. The Alexis FASD Services and its partners were successful recipients of a one-year grant in May 2019 to develop a community-led program focused on strengthening and mobilizing existing capacity in community.

Phase 1 of the ANSN-Policywise Community-based Integrated Mental Health
Services for Youth Project began October 1, 2019 and Phase 2 on July 1, 2020. Our
focus is UGICIGEBICEN, 'to help each other' strengthen and mobilize existing
supports for our youth. Services identified throughout the Policywise research*
included but not limited to:

- Sexual health ◆ Substance use/misuse ◆ Employment-training support ◆ Housing
- Education support Income assistance Peer support Transition support Renamed "ANSN Youth Hub", the program reports to ANSN Social Development and currently employs 3 staff; Supervisor, 2 Connectors for Youth.
